Super Fun Fluorescent Disco.

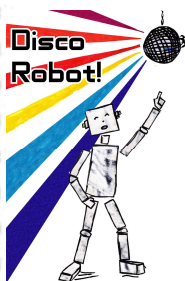
It is a \$2 entry per child and there will be food (juice
