## This funding will be used to

- Ensure all Year 3/5 students achieve NAPLAN NMS in all areas or have an evidence-based individual curriculum plan [ICP] or Intervention Action Plan [CIAP] to address their specific learning needs
- Provide intensive intervention to identified lower school students, to meet their own SMART goals
- Provide extension activities to identified students
- Increase the number of Year 5 students in the U2B across all 5 areas from 35% to 50% average

## Our initiatives include

- Purchase additional teacher aide time to provide intensive intervention for identified students
- Implement our school's 'Advancing Upper School' plan including electives and extension programs
- Purchase Brisbane SDE Unify 'Booster' courses for students identified as possible U2B
- Provide PD to develop teacher capability
