Reading Fluency

As mentioned in our previous newsletter, reading continues to be a significant focus in schools across the state and at Miallo State School. As part of our continued reading improvement journey, our teachers have begun to implement a practice called fluency pairs, whereby students will take turns reading a text to a partner on multiple occasions during the week. The text will first be modelled by the classroom teacher and students will then work to improve their accuracy, rate and prosody (expression, pausing and rhythm). In the upper grades, students will also provide feedback to each other in order to encourage further development and growth. This work will continue to strengthen the fantastic teaching and learning that our teachers are already facilitating in learning and we would appreciate your support at home by continuing to read with your children, reminding them that the same text can be read multiple times to improve our skills.
